**ATTENTION ALL INDEPENDENT LIVING RESIDENTS!**

- 1) **REGARDING YOUR RED FOLDERS:** It is of the utmost importance that you continue to update the information contained in your Red Folder (which should be kept on top of your refrigerator). If you should get a new diagnosis, a new medication added or even a medication discontinued, if your contact person or family member has had a change (i.e. new phone number), all this needs to be reflected in the information kept in this folder. This information is what will be used in case you have an emergency in the building. The First Responders will review it as they tend to your care and then the information will go along with you should you need to be transported to a hospital. If you need new forms just let the staff know and we'll provide them for you and copies will be made when you're completed.
- 2) **THE 2ND FLOOR LIBRARY (BALCONY AREA):** Do not turn off the ceiling lights nor the ceiling fans. The fans were installed to help circulate the heat from the dining room fireplace.

(Lazay-lay Bon-Tom Roulay) when translated means,

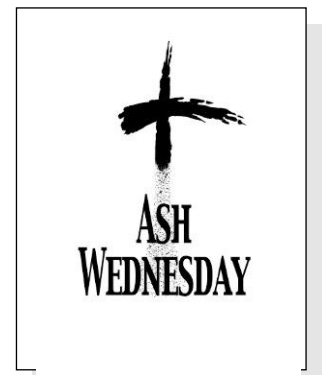
